## Membership Moment

At the October General Meeting, two motions regarding Membership and Range access fees were made, seconded and approved.

Effective January 1, 2019:

- 1) The Club Membership annual fee is increased from \$125 to \$135. The additional fee for OFAH membership remains \$45.
- 2) The range access fee is increased from \$20 to \$25.
- 3) Additionally, the Board of Directors has approved an initiation fee for **new Members only**, of \$50.
- 4) As well, the Board of Directors has approved implementation of a Family Membership plan at a fee of \$250. Family to consist of two adults and any number of children 17 and younger – under the supervision of an adult member.

Any Members renewing their Membership for the 2019 year or New members joining by December 31, 2018 will pay the lower fees; a reminder that to be eligible to participate in the 2019 elections for Club Directors and Officers, Membership fees must be paid by December 31, 2018.


