## GENERAL MEETING

February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026

**Roll Call:** Lea M. absent

A minute of silence was observed in memory of Carroll Norris who had been with the club for many years.

There were not enough members for a quorum. Therefore, there were no elections held.

**Treasurer's Report:** Cheques to Chalmers fuels for propane were \$958, \$1,289.23 and \$1,489. Taxes in March and May \$3,179 each and two more payments after that.

**Membership:** 6 applications were presented for consideration. Rui Tang and Youwen Zhang and Avery Tang (family membership), Leonardo Pujol Albini, Garfield Mathies, Wuqi Liu, Ryan Hesse, Amardeep Gill. 2 more applicants had payments pending. Ryan Hesse stood and introduced himself to the group. He is a butcher and cook. We will certainly need his skills at the club.. Sukhi moved to accept these applicants, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jamie.

**Field:** Please remember to check you outdoors card to ensure your hunting and fishing licences are valid. Remember to check ice thickness before heading out. Ron Brouillette and Jeff Forler had just returned from the Dorset area and augured a hole to find only 3 inches of ice on top with an unfrozen water layer under it. The significant snow cover had insulated it enough to keep it from freezing, despite sub -30 temps for extended periods of time. Steve Murray and Jeff Forler were out for Coyotes and were successful with 3 of them.

**Entertainment/Ways and Means:** We are actively researching Caterers to do the weddings that have been booked. Going forward at this point, future bookings will have to book their own Caterer. We are still booking events though. We still need some prizes for the Club Dinner on March 7. If you have any prizes to donate or know of someone, please contact a Director, thankyou.

**Property:** Blinking lights in the parking lot still to be fixed. We are waiting for parts. We are in need of a new cooler evaporator for the lounge beer cooler. The old one is just not reliable anymore. We got 3 quotes. 1) Stratus Air wanted \$7,345 (tax included), Mardel Electrical and Mechanical wanted \$5,056 (tax included) and Grewel HVAC Refrigeration offered a bid of \$3,955 (tax included). After discussion the Directors decided to go with the Grewel bid. One of our members went to his company and got us the best quote. Work to be done within a week. We have to be diligent on weekends with snowmobilers parking. Especially if we are having any events like wings or rentals.

**Sports and Innerclub:** Monday darts, WRG league darts on Wednesdays, and BB guns and archery on Sundays, are all doing well. Barry D'Costa praised the BB gun and archery club for how well they work with the kids. Kudos to Les Carnegie, Ron Brouillette and Jeff Forler.

**Bar:** Staff meeting to be arranged by Lea. We need to go over a few things and make sure all are on the same page. The new draught beer, Crystal Park Pilsner from Stockyard Brewing, is going over well. Will have to get some more.

**Lower Grounds:** Snow in the range being removed. Gate on the side of the range was removed to allow for a bigger tractor to get in. It was decided to put the gate back on until Mitchell (snow removal) says it is going to come.

**Sargeant at Arms:** Have notice a few beer can cartons around. The kind we don't sell. I'm guessing snowmobilers. It should be mentioned to the snowmobile association(s), that tailgating is strictly prohibited.

**Unfinished Business:** Rob Penner suggested we have a hard copy of the new constitution at the bar for anyone who does not have access to email. Good idea.

**Treasurer's Report:** Paid march tax bill of \$3,179. Waste Management \$280, Chalmers Fuels \$700, OFAH \$3,025, bill for fixing the lounge beer fridge is \$3,500.  
Barry D'Costa was appointed to the board of directors. Brad is going to mentor Barry for being the Treasurer. Brad will remain on the board as Director of Sports and Innerclub.

**Membership:** 4 applications were presented for consideration. Tom Van Oosterhout, Johnathon Scolari. Mark Mckintosh and Ritchie Taylor have not paid yet. Tom and Johnathon were accepted. Mark and Ritchie will be accepted upon payment of Fees. Sukhi moved to accept, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Brad. CARRIED  
Sukhi suggested that we raise our fees. After discussion we came up with the following: Basic "social" membership will stay at \$150. Range fees will increase to \$100. March 21 is wing night in the Lounge. March 21 and 28 there are stag and does in the hall. Home Hardware event in the Moser Hall on April 18. Last chicken wing night of the season is also on the 18, in the Lounge. April 25, a stag and doe. May 2 is Victoria Bowl event in the Hall.

**Property:** Beer cooler in the Lounge was fixed. Jeff Forler made strips of paper with notice to snowmobilers that there is NO PARKING on our property on Friday, Saturday or Sunday.
