DIRECTORS' MEETING

February 17th, 2026

Roll Call: Lea M. absent. Minutes of last Directors' meeting were read.

Treasurer's Report: A deposit of \$12,223 was made. Also, two cheques worth \$771.50 were deposited. The big deposit included last wing night and the Club Dinner. Barry D'Costa discussed expenses and profits & would like to see detailed breakdown of our costs, expenses, profits from our Accountant and Bookkeeper.

Membership: 5 paid membership applications were presented for consideration. 2 unpaid membership applications will be considered after receiving payment of fees. The 5 applicants are Manveer Singh, Jagjot Ghuman, Matthew Guille, Junyan He and Shahnawaz Rentia. Sukhi moved to accept the 5 applicants, 2nd by Jamie. CARRIED

Field: Antlerless deer draw is open. Deadline is June 30. Spring wild turkey tags are available and the primary allocation for the moose draw opens on April 1. Changes are coming to the moose draw in 2027 to increase hunter opportunities. The Ministry will release details at a later date. Starting July 1st this year there is a \$50 penalty added to a license when a hunter fails to report twice in a row. The previous 1 year prevent from purchase penalty has been eliminated.

Entertainment/Ways and Means: The Club Dinner went very well. A big thanks to all the volunteers who helped make it a success. New member Ryan Hesse stepped up as head chef. Well done. There was some confusion on raffle tickets, colours of tickets and costs. Next year the tickets should be there the day before the dinner along with signage with ticket colours, cost and which each ticket is for.

Next Bingo is April 11th. Kim would like to have a meeting and make sure everyone is on the same page. Dean Godin will be doing food. He would like to try pizza and see how that goes. Sukhi suggested that the club hold a small dinner for volunteers of big events like the Club Dinner and New Years Eve.

Property: The lights outside that blink on and off will be fixed once the weather is better. Jim Remus to do the fix.

Sports and Innerclub: BB Gun and Archery has their last day on March 28. A tear down and storage day will have to be organized. Monday Darts and WRG Dart leagues doing well.

Bar: Discussion on new cash registers. They will be looked into. Nobody has complained about the price increase. In fact, some members have said they would have raised it a little more. New Friday hours are 1pm to 5pm.

Lower Grounds: Our range will be inspected in the fall. Aaron Kemp showed some preliminary drawings of possible 50 and 25 yard range. A question of how many stations could be in the 100 yard range if the shotgun target was moved to a new 25 yard range. The burm for the new section of range is first up. John M. to call the CFO and invite him to come to the club to discuss our plans. Then we could proceed confidently.

Jeff Callow has offered to fix up the archery range. He knows he can ask for help when needed.
