DIRECTORS' MEETING

June 23rd, 2026

Roll Call: All present.

Minutes of the last Directors Meeting were read.

Treasurer's Report: Received \$650 from Highwaymen Car Club. Big bills were Service Master (fixing water damage) \$2,500, \$936 and \$340. Golden Cleaning \$588. OFAH \$1,050. Chalmers fuel \$1,049. Waste Management \$632. Fly Club owes for Hydro, due at the end of June. Brad sent a message but has not received a reply. They also owe us \$5,000 for snow plowing expenses this past two years.

Membership: 5 members approved through text. William Flaherty, Honey Gandhi, Mikhail Gogolev, Grant Lewis and Cameron Stutt (family membership). There are also 7 new member applications. Garnet Koebel, Razi Farooqui, Stephen Palmateer, Darren Thomas, Ravjot Singh, Jan Vrba & John Chui. Sukhi moved to accept these applicants, 2nd by Douglas. CARRIED. We now have 331 active paying members.

Field: Deadline for antlerless deer draw is June 30th. Controlled deer draw available July 1. Deadline for this is July 31. Moose 2nd chance allocation is open until July 7. Smallmouth Bass opens Saturday, June 27.

Entertainment/Ways and Means: There was a good turnout for the Waterloo-Wellington Dental event. July 16 is Mitchell Landscaping Trap and Dinner. Looking at Davenport Catering to do the dinner. July 11 is the Motorcycle Ride for Kevin. Will need folding table outside with three chairs. Jamie can do this as he is also riding in this event. They will be using the lounge upon their return. July 25 is Sundance Balloons in the Lounge. July 26 is the Volvo Car show. August 29 is the WRG Pig Roast in the Moser Hall. Range closures because of Clemmer rentals are making it difficult for members to shoot on weekends. We can start orientations earlier. (10:30 am-12:00 pm).

Property/Lower Grounds: We need another plumber to install a water softener. Sukhi to check members for someone. Starlink internet has been installed. No issues so far. Wireless link to the Range to be put in. Aaron presented a diagram with possible placement of new Trap House. After discussion, a spot was agreed to. Talk of purchasing a shed for this. The old outhouse was talked about. After discussion it was decided to tear down the old outhouse and put in Port-a-potties. Brad checked with Jamie Avon (from darts) who works for a company relatd to this. Initial quote was \$150 for each one. They clean it and remove the waste. Kim to look for a second quote. A Drone company wants to use our archery range to test out some of their drones. We need to know when, and how long they need it for. We also need to know what financial compensation they will make for this. Sukhi to get this info from them. We are trying to get the CFO to review our plans for the new range. So far she is not replying. John to keep trying. Someone has been taking some of the poles from the pole pile, cutting off the ends and leaving the butts there. It is expensive to clean up. Someone who asked for some poles cleaned up after that and it cost them \$500 at the dump. It was suggested the club reimburse him \$300. All agreed. The Fly Club is still flying over the trap range while people are shooting. John to talk to their president again.

Sports and Innerclub: Good turnout for Men's horseshoes. 15 to 16 guys playing. Ladies not throwing horseshoes but are having a card night every second Wednesday. July 8 is the next card night.
