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DIRECTORS' MEETING

August 17th, 2026

Roll Call: John Mitchell, Jeff Forler, Jeff Calow – absent
Minutes of last Directors Meeting were read.

Treasurer's Report: Some bigger expenditures are \$494 to Todd for bar supplies, Waste Management \$917, Davenport Catering \$971.80, Township of Woolwich \$3,495.06 (Tax installment), Block Three brewing \$225.15, Furs, Fins and Feathers \$700, Glen Briar Home Hardware \$340.38.
Libro Bank is changing fees for deposits. Rob Gross to talk to Libro about this.
An estimate of \$5,500 given to Mitchell Landscaping for our expenses for the Trap and Dinner they had. This was a request from them.

Membership: 15 new member applications since July. 14 were previously approved. Alex Guenther is the other candidate. Sukhi moved to accept, 2nd by Brad, CARRIED

Field: Moose 2nd chance allocation results are available. Bear has opened in some northern WMU's with additional WMU seasons opening on Sept. 1st and 8th. Controlled deer draw results available Sept. 1.

Entertainment/Ways and Means: July 11 Kevins Motorcycle Ride was a good success. Member Dave Nunikoven and Judy Sheppard installed missing letters on the Club entrance sign and painted one side of it. Many thanks. Mitchell Landscaping event went well. Volvo Car Show went well. Sebastian from Sundance Balloons held an event that went well. The Volkswagen car show had been getting the big tent for free, not sure why but from here on in they will be charged for the tent if they request it. Some car events don't sell enough food to make it worth doing the food for. Between expenses and trying to get volunteers. Each event will be discussed as to whether or not we provide food. Some could opt for having a food truck do the food.
Moser Hall had few bookings. Sept. 1, Les Carnegie is organizing a Rotary Trap Shoot and Dinner. Oct. 24 and 25 is the Aquarium Society event in Moser Hall and part of the lounge. October 31 would have been Halloween Bingo. This event will be move to Friday October 30 instead. We need to have tickets for the pig roast made up. Aaron to do this. Garbage pick up should move to every two weeks instead of once a month. When does our contract with Waste Management expire? We should look at other companies. A request for a Sky Lift was made in order to finish painting the Club sign at the entrance. Rob G. to look into this. A request to the Fly Club will be made to help us roll the grass where the cop cars put ruts in it. Too hard to cut the grass the way it is.

Sports and Innerclub: Mens Horseshoes are getting 16 to 20 guys a week playing. A few ladies throw on a Wednesday night. Wednesday night cards is humming along.

Bar: New system (POS) is up and running. Todd will be joining each Bar Tender on one of their shifts to go through it and train. We've hired a new bar tender, Michelle Coon. Please make her feel welcome. Direct Deposit for pay is almost ready.
